 - a. **Ordinance No. 19-2020** - AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 1143.08, PARKING OF RECREATIONAL VEHICLES, AS CONTAINED IN CHAPTER 1143, EXTERIOR MAINTENANCE, OF TITLE THREE, LOCAL BUILDING PROVISIONS, OF PART ELEVEN, BUILDING CODE, OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF SEVEN HILLS, OHIO. **Third Reading.**
 - b. **Ordinance No. 32-2020** - AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE CITY OF SEVEN HILLS AND THE COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA FOR THE USE OF CUYAHOGA COUNTY'S MASS NOTIFICATION SYSTEM ('READY NOTIFY'). **Third Reading.**
 - c. **Resolution No. 10-2020** - A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO CREATE A FUND ENTITLED 'LOCAL CORONAVIRUS RELIEF FUND'; THE CITY OF SEVEN HILLS AFFIRMS THAT MONIES IN THIS FUND SHALL BE USED TO COVER COSTS CONSISTENT WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 5001 OF THE "CORONAVIRUS AID, RELIEF, AND ECONOMIC SECURITY ACT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. **First Reading.**

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- d. **Ordinance No. 34-2020** - AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO PARTICIPATE IN THE DISTRIBUTION OF FEDERAL CORONAVIRUS RELIEF FUNDING TO LOCAL SUBDIVISIONS THROUGH THE COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA CORONAVIRUS RELIEF DISTRIBUTION FUND; AUTHORIZING SUCH AMOUNT RECEIVED TO BE DEPOSITED IN THE CITY'S LOCAL CORONAVIRUS RELIEF FUND AND MONIES EXPENDED FROM SUCH FUND BE USED TO COVER ONLY COSTS INCURRED BY THE CITY CONSISTENT WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 5001 OF THE "CORONAVIRUS AID, RELIEF, AND ECONOMIC SECURITY ACT" AS DESCRIBED IN 42 U.S.C. 601(D); AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

- e. **Ordinance No. 35-2020** - AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A 'FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT FOR SANITARY AND STORM SEWER MAINTENANCE WITHIN THE CITY OF SEVEN HILLS, OHIO', ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF SEVEN HILLS, OHIO, WITH THE COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, ON BEHALF OF THE CUYAHOGA COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, FOR THE PURPOSE OF EXPANDING THE SCOPE OF THE AGREEMENT TO HAVE THE COUNTY MAINTAIN THE CITY PLANTS. **First Reading.**
- f. **Ordinance No. 36-2020** - AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF SEVEN HILLS, OHIO, WITH SAFEbuilt OHIO, LLC, FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING SERVICES FOR AS-NEEDED INSPECTIONS AND PLAN REVIEWS, ALONG WITH THE CBO ROLE IN THE CITY'S BUILDING DEPARTMENT, FOR A TWELVE-MONTH PERIOD, WHICH SHALL AUTOMATICALLY RENEW FOR AN ADDITIONAL TWELVE-MONTH PERIOD UNLESS PRIOR NOTIFICATION TO TERMINATE IS GIVEN. **First Reading.**
- g. **Ordinance No. 37-2020** - AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF SEVEN HILLS, OHIO, WITH AMERICAN FIREWORKS COMPANY OF HUDSON, OHIO, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SELLING, FURNISHING, DELIVERING, AND PRESENTING TWO (2) FIREWORKS DISPLAYS FOR THE CITY OF SEVEN HILLS 2020 HOMEDAYS, AND APPROPRIATING A SUM NOT TO EXCEED \$8,500.00 FOR SAID SERVICE.

- h. **Ordinance No. 38-2020** - AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF SEVEN HILLS, OHIO, WITH COURTVIEW JUSTICE SOLUTIONS (dba EQUIVANT) OF CANTON, OHIO, FOR THE PURPOSE OF PERFORMING ANNUAL MAINTENANCE AND SUPPORT OF THE MAYOR'S COURT LEGACY CASE MANAGEMENT SYSTEM SOFTWARE AND THE RIGHT-TO-USE LICENSE, AND APPROPRIATING THE SUM NOT TO EXCEED \$2,660.00 FOR SAID SERVICE. **First Reading.**
